### **Operating Budget Monitoring Report - December 31, 2019**

#### **SUMMARY**

The purpose of this report is to provide the Toronto Public Library (TPL) Board with a summary of the gross and net operating expenditures of TPL for the year ending December 31, 2019. TPL's Council-approved 2019 operating budget is \$188.093 million net (\$207.314 million gross).

For the year ending December 31, 2019, TPL is essentially on budget and reporting a favourable net expenditure variance of \$0.021 million, which will be returned to the City, comprised of a favourable revenue variance of \$2.654 million and an unfavourable expenditure variance of \$2.634 million.

#### FINANCIAL IMPACT

For the year ending December 31, 2019, TPL is essentially on budget and reporting a favourable net expenditure variance of \$0.021 million, comprised of a favourable revenue variance of \$2.654 million and an unfavourable expenditure variance of \$2.634 million. The surplus of \$0.021 million will be returned to the City.

The Director, Finance & Treasurer has reviewed this financial impact statement and agrees with it.

#### ISSUE BACKGROUND

TPL's initial Council-approved <u>2019 operating budget</u> was \$187.659 million net (\$206.880 million gross). During 2019, the City made minor adjustments comprised of an increase of \$0.434 million net related to the insurance allocation algorithm and

insurance reserve fund, which resulted in a revised 2019 operating budget of \$188.093 million net (\$207.314 million gross).

#### COMMENTS

For the year ending December 31, 2019, TPL is reporting a favourable net expenditure variance of \$0.021 million, as shown in Table 1 below:

The favourable revenue variance of \$2.654 million is mainly attributable to increased grants from the TPL Foundation (\$2.880 million) to enhance specific library initiatives and greater than budgeted other revenues (\$0.247 million, including sale of used library materials) and is partially offset by lower than budgeted fines and fees revenues (\$0.528 million). The unfavourable variance in fines revenues is the result of the increased usage of e-materials, which are automatically returned and not subject to fines, and the introduction of additional on-line methods for patrons to manage their library records and avoid fines by renewing or returning outstanding library materials.

The unfavourable expenditure variance of \$2.634 million is mainly attributable to: expenditures related to specific library initiatives, which are fully funded by grants from the TPL Foundation (\$2.880 million); greater than budgeted spending for branch security in order to ensure the safety of customers and staff; and additional spending on infrastructure maintenance as a result of urgent repairs to building components and systems; partially offset by a favourable expenditure variance in utilities resulting from the relatively mild summer.

These operating results should be considered draft until the external audit of the financial statements is completed.
