Getting Started with Medici.tv

Medici is an online classical music channel that lets you livestream concerts, ballets, and operas in addition to documentaries and master classes. The Medici site is available in English, French and Spanish and Russian.

What you need

- A valid Toronto Public Library card
- A computer, tablet or mobile device with an internet connection*

How to access Medici.tv

- 1. Go to <u>www.tpl.ca</u> and enter "medici.tv" in the search box or use <u>www.tpl.ca/medici</u>
- 2. Click on Access Online
- 3. Enter your library card number and PIN

How to browse or search Medici.tv

You can search or browse. Search by title of a work, name of composer or director or keyword such as "soprano". Browse by concerts, operas, ballets, documentaries or master classes. Further refine by director, Video-On-Demand, Lives/Replays or composers.

Navigate through a video by clicking on the chapters found on the right. You can watch in full screen mode by clicking the double arrow on the right.



Subtitles and public performance rights are offered for some programs.



All live streams are available on replay from the homepage under Must-See Replays.


Event Calendar
